- 1. Parent Letters** - All schools using Frax have access to our Frax [parent letters](#). These handouts introduce Frax and its methodology to families, provide login credentials, and encourage parents to explore key fraction learning goals with their child.
- 2. Support Students At Home** - Once students complete all of their Frax Missions, they gain access to the [Sector Review](#) where they can continue their journey towards fractions mastery outside of the classroom. In the Sector Review students get to practice the concepts they've learned through engaging daily mini games at home. Parents can:
 - Encourage their child to achieve the green light daily, indicating a good day's fractions practice
 - Help their child track their green light goals
 - Celebrate their child's in-game successes such as earning tokens, unlocking achievements, and revealing new games and activities
- 3. Understanding Checks** - Parents can monitor their child's fraction understanding by having conversations. Learning is best done collaboratively! Frax encourages parents to work with their child to help them develop understanding. If any knowledge gaps occur, families and schools can work together to address them. Parents can:
 - Ask their children about what they learned in their Frax mission
 - Have conversations about fractions and ask them questions about the material
