How to be a Successful STEM Professional

Set Your Goals

When we want to achieve big things, we need to set goals. Goals help you attain the future you want.

To set your goals, you should:

- Write down your goals. (What are your goals?)
- Make an action plan. (How will you achieve them?)
- Create a timeline. (When will you achieve them?)
- Get started!



What's a Vision Board?

A **Vision Board** is a tool that helps you visualize what you want to accomplish in the future.

With a Vision Board, you create a collage of pictures and words that represent your goals.


The board serves as a daily reminder of what you want to achieve and helps motivate you to make your vision a reality.




Your STEM Career Vision Board

Creating Your Vision Board

When making your vision board, you can:

Use poster board, paper, markers, and pictures to make your Vision Board.




Use slides or a document to put together images and words to make your Vision Board.

Plan Your Vision Board

Before you make your Vision Board, you need to plan what pictures and text you want to use.

When planning, brainstorm about the education, training, and skills needed for your chosen career.

Some information you will need to research and look up.




Research and Brainstorm

Where do you see yourself working? How much will you earn?	

Use Your Plan to Start Your Vision Board

Once you've filled out the Research and Brainstorming document, you can start finding pictures for your Vision Board.

Remember, pictures should be related to your STEM career and goals.



Example

What STEM career do you want to pursue?	I want to be a computer programmer.	
Why do you want to pursue this career?	I like to work with computers and want to design websites.	
What qualities to do have that will help you in this career?	I am smart and like to problem solve. I also enjoy creating new things.	
What skills do you need to be successful in this career?	I will need to know coding language like HTML.	
What kind of training or education do you need? What subject will your study?	I will need to take coding classes. I will also need to get a Bachelor's in computer science.	
What are some career duties and responsibilities?	I will be required to fix bugs in existing code; code and test programming software; and develop computer applications.	
What steps will you take to be successful in this career?	I will get good grades to get scholarships. Also, I will apply for internships and go to coding camp.	
Where do you see yourself working? How much will you earn?	I would like to work for Google. Computer programmers can make 100k.
